EXHIBIT A
(Standard Agreement)

SCOPE OF WORK

5. Detailed description of work to be performed:
- A. The weapons firing range use shall be limited to CHP personnel assigned to the Yreka Area office. Maximum number of CHP personnel using firing range: 36.
 - B. Contractor agrees that CHP shall have the use of all on-site firearms buildings located on the firing range for training programs. The classroom facility may be used on a case-by-case, without additional charge, when arranged through the Range Master.
 - C. Contractor and CHP agree the weapons firing range shall be open and usable by members of CHP at such times that are mutually agreeable to both parties. Exclusive use of the facilities by CHP must be coordinated and mutually agreed to by both parties.
 - D. The CHP agrees that its members using the weapons firing range facilities under this Agreement shall be governed by the range safety rules established by Contractor.
 - E. Brass will be retained by Contractor.
 - F. The weapons firing range must be able to accommodate the following:
 - 1) .40 caliber pistol (**Frangible ammunition only**).
 - a. Twelve (12) shoots per year, one (1) each month or two (2) every other month.
 - b. Two (2) qualification shoots which must be performed at the following distances: 3 yards, 4 yards, 7 yards, 10 yards, 15 yards, and 25 yards.
 - c. Ten (10) practice shoots, of which two (2) night shoots are recommended.
 - d. Use for make-up shoots at times mutually agreeable to both parties.
 - 2) Shotgun (00 buckshot).
 - a. Eight (8) shoots per year (two (2) quarterly).
 - b. Two (2) night shoots required.
 - c. Distance 15 yards maximum.
 - G. Inspection and test firing of weapons:
 - 1) All weapons are to be test fired after each required inspection by the Area Weapons Range Officer.
 - 2) Use of facility to test fire weapons will be coordinated between the Area Weapons Range Officer and the Contractor.

EXHIBIT D
(Standard Agreement)

SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. CHP and Siskiyou County Sheriff's Department each reserves the right to cancel this Agreement with thirty (30) days advance written notice to both parties.
2. In the event of an unforeseen emergency, CHP or Siskiyou County Sheriff's Department may cancel this Agreement without prior notice and without compensation to both parties.
3. Agreement may be amended by mutual written consent of the parties hereto.
4. Contractor represents that there are no existing environmental actions or concerns known to exist as to the property to be used for the purpose of this Agreement, and that Contractor is currently in compliance with all appropriate federal and state environmental obligations including, but not limited to lead mitigation. Contractor agrees that compliance with these obligations is the sole responsibility of the Contractor.
5. Siskiyou County Sheriff's Department agrees to provide CHP with a resolution, motion, order or ordinance of the governing body, which authorizes execution of this Agreement, and indicates the individual who is authorized to sign the Agreement on behalf of Siskiyou County Sheriff's Department.
