

**SECOND ADDENDUM TO CONTRACT FOR SERVICES
BY INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR
(Storm Water Analysis Monitoring for Landfills, Contract #5232013)**

THIS SECOND ADDENDUM is to that Contract executed on May 23, 2013 between the County of Siskiyou ("County") and BC Laboratories, Inc. ("Contractor") and as amended on _____, and is entered into this ____ day of June, 2020.

WHEREAS, the Contract expires on June 30, 2020 and services continued to be required after that date; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to extend the term of the Contract;

WHEREAS, the cost of services to be provided under the contract is expected to exceed the amount provided in the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to increase the amount of compensation payable under the Contract.

NOW THEREFORE, THE PARTIES MUTUALLY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

Paragraph 1.01 of the Contract for Services shall be amended to extend the term of the Contract through June 30, 2025.

Paragraph 3.01 shall be amended to repeal Exhibit "A" in its entirety and replace it with the new Exhibit "A", effective July 1, 2020, attached hereto; and

Paragraph 4.01 of the Contract, Compensation, shall be amended to add an additional two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) per fiscal year, to increase the total compensation payable under the Contract to an amount not to exceed thirty thousand dollars (\$30,000).

All other terms and conditions of the Contract shall remain in full force and effect.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, County and Contractor have executed this agreement on the dates set forth below, each signatory represents that he/she has the authority to execute this agreement and to bind the Party on whose behalf his/her execution is made.
