

**Scope of Work**

Noxious Weed Control along State Highways in Siskiyou County

- 1. **LOCAL AGENCY** shall furnish all labor, material and equipment to control noxious weeds as listed in CCR Title 3 Section 4500 within State Highway rights of way in Siskiyou County through the use of chemicals, manual grubbing or biological control.
  
- 2. **LOCAL AGENCY** shall notify Department Contract Manager, Thomas March (530) 225-2460 FIVE (5) days prior to beginning work in the area All the chemical applications will be subject the current schedule of the Siskiyou County agriculture Department, depending on the weather conditions, weed growth and availability of spray crews.
  
- 3. All inquiries during the term of this agreement will be directed to the project representatives listed below.

- 4. **TREATMENT LOCATIONS**
  - State Route 3 (Trinity county line to Yreka City limits)
  - Route I-5 (Shasta county line to Oregon border)
  - State Route 89 (Shasta county line to I-5 intersection)
  - State Route 96 (Humbolt county line to I-5 intersection)
  - US Highway 97 (Weed City Limits to Oregon border)
  - State Route 161 (Intersection of US 97 to 139 Intersection)
  - State Route 263 (intersection of State route 3 to Intersection of State route 96)

Additional treatment locations may be added with the prior approval of the Caltrans Contract Manager.

5. **LOCAL AGENCY** agrees to only use Chemical products listed on the approved State list of materials during the agreement.

Agency will bill accordingly for the replacement chemical. Chemical prices listed above may be subject to change. The Agency will bill accordingly for the current price of chemical.
