

Notice of Public Hearing

The Siskiyou County Board of Supervisors will hold a Public Hearing on Tuesday, December 1, 2020, at 9:00a.m. or as soon thereafter as may be heard, in the Board of Supervisors' Chambers, Siskiyou County Courthouse, 311 Fourth Street, Yreka, California, to consider two (2) ordinances, one entitled: An ordinance of the County of Siskiyou amending Chapter 3 of Title 7 of the Siskiyou County Code regarding the duties of the Director of Public Works; and the second entitled: An ordinance of the County of Siskiyou adding Section 7-4.02 to Chapter 4 of Title 7 of the Siskiyou County Code regarding the Department of General Services.

All interested persons are invited to be present and be heard thereon or present comments in writing to the Board of Supervisors, 510 North Main Street, Yreka, CA 96097. It is advised that the presenter bring 7 copies of anything presented to the Board and that the presenter create copies in advance for their own records. If you are unable to attend the public hearing, you may direct written comments to the Board of Supervisors, 510 North Main Street, Yreka, CA 96097.

All public records related to an open session item on the agenda, which are not exempt from disclosure pursuant to the California Public Records Act, that are distributed to a **majority of** the legislative body will be available for public inspection at 510 North Main Street, Yreka, CA 96097 at the same time that the public records are distributed or made available to a majority of the members of the legislative body. All supporting documentation is available for public review in the office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, located in the Siskiyou County Clerk's Office, 510 North Main Street, Yreka, CA 96097, during regular business hours, 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.

If you challenge the proposed ordinance in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Board of Supervisors at, or prior to, the public hearing.
