Each of these individuals is an active volunteer with the sole provider of EMS ground transportation in the McCloud service area of Siskiyou County. This area is not only a rural and sparsely populated portion of Siskiyou County, but is also remote. The District extends South at Snowman's Hill on Hwy 89 to the County line near dead horse summit and includes the McCloud ZIB. Additionally, Siskiyou County's unincorporated population is well below the 125,000 person requirement of this section as per the latest federal census.

The need for drivers in this area is severe. There is an immediate need to enable the above listed individuals to drive for the volunteer ambulance in order to continue to provide locally based EMS services in McCloud and surrounding service areas.
