NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that PacificCorp, an Oregon corporation, has filed an application with the County of Siskiyou requesting that the County renew its utility franchise through the grant of a franchise pursuant to the Franchise Act of 1937, to construct, maintain and use electrical lines and appurtenances for transmitting and distributing electricity for any and all lawful purposes in, along, across, upon, and under the public streets and places within the unincorporated area of the County of Siskiyou.

If such franchise shall be granted, PacificCorp, hereinafter designated Grantee, during the term of such franchise will pay to the County a sum annually which shall be equivalent to two percent (2%) of the gross annual receipts of such Grantee arising from the use, operation, or possession of such franchise; except provided that this payment shall not be less than one percent (1%) of the gross annual receipts derived by the Grantee from the sale of electricity within the unincorporated area of the County. In the event such payment is not made the franchise will be subject to being forfeited. The term of the proposed franchise is 15 years. The County proposes to grant such franchise.

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that the Siskiyou County Board of Supervisors will hold a Public Hearing on Tuesday, June 15, 2021, at 9:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as may be heard, in the Board of Supervisors' Chambers, Courthouse, 311 Fourth Street, Yreka, California, on such franchise and any and all persons having any objections to the granting of such franchise may appear before the Board of Supervisors via teleconference/Zoom. It is unknown at this time whether the public hearing will be held via ZOOM/teleconference only. This decision will be made based upon COVID 19 infection rates as the

meeting date approaches and will be set forth on the meeting agenda posted both online and physically the Friday before the meeting. If the public is allowed to attend in-person, all interested persons are invited to be present and be heard thereon or present

objections and comments in writing to the Board of Supervisors.

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that at any time not later than the hour set for hearing objections, any person interested may make written protest stating objections against the granting of such franchise; which protest must be signed by the protestant and be delivered to the Clerk of the Board. You may direct written comments or objections to the Board of Supervisors, 510 North Main Street, Yreka, CA 96097 or the following email: wendy@sisvotes.org. The Board of Supervisors at the time set for hearing such objections shall proceed to hear and pass upon all protests so made.
