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## 2010 District Populations

The County of Siskiyou last redistricted in 2011 with a supervisorial-based process. The populations of each district at that time were based on the 2010 Decennial Census.<sup>1</sup>

## Population Growth and Deviations

The US Census has released in a “Legacy Format” the data from the decennial census, identifying the whole count of persons and where they resided as of April 1, 2020. Redistricting Partners has concluded the work of placing this data into the census blocks, block groups, and tracts.

This data represents the whole population data prior to a state required reallocation of prison population that will be conducted by the Statewide Database at UC Berkeley. This adjusted data will be completed in the coming weeks and updated counts will be provided at that time.

Based on this data, the county has decreased in population by 824 residents, or -1.8%, since the last decennial census. This is below the state’s population change of 6.1%. At the district level, District 3 was the only one to see an increase of residents – 449 people with a 4.9% growth

rate – and the largest decrease in population was experienced in District 1, which lost 832 people and had a negative growth rate of 9.5%.

With a countywide population of 44,076, the ideal population for any district would be 8,815. The seat with the largest population is District 4 at 9,644 (+9.4%) and the smallest is District 1 at 7,903 (-10.3%), placing the county at a total deviation of 19.7%, well above the 10% deviation range maximum.
