

**Notice of Public Hearing to discuss the Close-Out of Community Development Block  
Grant Project  
“PI Only - Siskiyou County Public Facility Acquisition”**

Notice is hereby given that the Siskiyou County Board of Supervisors will conduct a public hearing on November 2, 2021, at 9:00 a.m., or as soon thereafter as may be heard, in the Board of Supervisors Chambers located at 311 4<sup>th</sup> Street in Yreka, to discuss the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Close-out Report for PI Only – Siskiyou County Public Facility Acquisition.

The purpose of the public hearing is to present the close-out report to the Board of Supervisors and receive comments from citizens on the expenditure of \$99,072.82 of State CDBG Program Income funds for the acquisition of the Hornbrook Community Center located at 15439 Hornbrook Road in Hornbrook. This activity met the CDBG National Objective of “Benefit Low-Moderate Income Persons”.

In light of the current COVID-19 pandemic, if you are interested in reviewing supporting documents pertaining to this issue, please contact the County Clerk’s Office at 530-842-8015 to ensure that the office is open to the public.

The public may attend by ZOOM/teleconference, but it is unknown at this time whether the public hearing will be held via ZOOM/teleconference only. This decision will be made based upon COVID 19 infection rates as the meeting date approaches and will be set forth on the meeting agenda posted both online and physically the Friday before the meeting.

All supporting documentation is available for public review in the office of the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors, located in the Siskiyou County Clerk’s Office, 311 Fourth Street, Room 201, Yreka, CA 96097, during regular business hours, 9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. - 4:00 p.m., Monday through Friday.
