The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) District 2 and Siskiyou County share a vision to reduce litter and illegal dumping in Siskiyou County by partnering together to provide "Free Dump Day Events" for Siskiyou County residents as part of the Clean California initiative.

The Clean California initiative expands state and local litter abatement efforts and provides thousands of job opportunities. As part of the litter pick-up expansion component, Caltrans is proposing "Free Dump Day Events" where the public can dispose of their waste materials safely and properly at no cost to them.

Current "Free Dump Day Events" are planned on the following dates:

- March 19, 2022 at the Oberlin Transfer Station: 2420 Oberlin Road, Yreka, CA 96097
- April 16, 2022 at the Black Butte Transfer Station: 3710 Springhill Road, Mount Shasta 96067
- May 21, 2022 at the Oberlin Transfer Station: 2420 Oberlin Road, Yreka, CA 96097
- May 21, 2022 at the Tulelake Transfer Station: County Road 95001, Tulelake, CA 96134 (south of Stateline Road, west of Sheepy Ridge)
- May 21, 2022 at the Happy Camp Transfer Station: 65600 Hwy 96, Happy Camp, CA 96039

Caltrans hopes to continue working with the County to plan future additional events. A Clean California utility account will be established with Siskiyou County to pay agreed-upon disposal fees. Invoices will be sent directly to the
