

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SISKIYOU
ACCEPTING VARIOUS DONATIONS FROM THE
SISKIYOU COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY**

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 25355 authorizes the Board of Supervisors to receive gifts and donations on behalf of the County,

WHEREAS, the Siskiyou County Historical Society has potential claims to ownerships of certain buildings and equipment currently located in the Outdoor Museum to the County of Siskiyou; and

WHEREAS such buildings include the Spring School, the Blacksmith Shop, the Callahan Church, the Skid Shack, the Big Wheels Logging Arch, the Miner’s Cabin, the Davis Cabin, the Denny Bar Store replica, a storage shed located in the rear of the property, and

WHEREAS such equipment includes the Case Steam Tractor and any and all other large tractors and/or pieces of agricultural equipment including, but not limited to, harvesters, rakes and hay balers; and

WHEREAS, the Siskiyou County Historical Society wishes to relinquish any claims and donate the buildings and equipment to the County of Siskiyou as a permanent part of the County Museum; and

WHEREAS, the Siskiyou County Historical Society has presented a further letter as to some items of personal property regarding a table saw, a child-size school desk identified by “Yreka Preservation” on the underside of the seat, and “QR Code” signs mounted on buildings and equipment, which letter is attached hereto as Exhibit A;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County of Siskiyou accepts the donations from the Siskiyou County Historical Society as described above; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Michael Perry, the Library and Museum Director, is authorized to execute the letter attached hereto as Exhibit A.
