RE: Section 106 consultation for the surrender of the Lower Klamath Project Built Environment Determinations of Eligibility

Dear Ms. Linton,

The California State Historic Preservation Officer (SHPO) received a consultation letter from the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) dated May 13, 2022 pursuant to Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 (54 U.S.C. § 300101), as amended, and its implementing regulation, 36 CFR Part 800.

That letter formally requested SHPO concurrence on determinations of eligibility for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP) made by the Klamath River Renewal Corporation by letter dated May 2, 2022. The SHPO responded by formal letter dated July 6, 2022 with a request for additional information. That information was provided to the SHPO in a letter dated December 6, 2022 from the Klamath River Renewal Corporation along with the following document:

- *Memorandum AECOM to Klamath River Renewal Corporation RE: Historic Built Environment Technical Report Review and Concurrence; Lower Klamath Project (FERC Project No. 14803); SHPO Ref. No. FERC_2018_0507_001 (Memo).*

The Memo provides a summary table of resources as requested and states that findings are unchanged since FERC approved the Built Environment Report (*Lower Klamath Project Historic Built Environment Technical Report, Klamath River Renewal Corporation, May 2022*).

Following review of the documentation provided, pursuant to 36 CFR § 800.4(c)(2), I **concur** with the determinations of eligibility for inclusion in the NRHP made in Attachment #1 (attached).
