**AN URGENCY ORDINANCE OF THE COUNTY OF SISKIYOU,
STATE OF CALIFORNIA, REDUCING A SPEED LIMIT AND THEREBY
AMENDING
SECTION 3-4.609 OF ARTICLE 6 OF CHAPTER 4 OF TITLE 3
OF THE SISKIYOU COUNTY CODE
REGARDING A SPEED LIMIT CHANGE**

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SISKIYOU ORDAINS
AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I: Section 3-4.609, of Article 6, of Chapter 4, of Title 3 Section 3-4.609
“45 mile speed limit” is hereby amended to read as follows:

- (aa) On 99-97 Cutoff Road, (County Road A12, 6K01) from eastbound at Post
Mile 7.27 and westbound at Post Mile 8.52

SECTION II: Constitutionality: If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or
phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional, such decision
shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this ordinance. The Board of
Supervisors hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each section,
subsection, sentence, clause or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or
more sections, subsections, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared
unconstitutional.

SECTION III: This ordinance is an ordinance for the immediate preservation of
the peace, health, and safety of the public and shall take effect immediately in
accordance with Section 25123(d) of the Government Code of the State of California.
An engineering & traffic study was conducted on this section of the roadway which
justifies the recommended speed limit. The Board of Supervisors finds and declares that
this speed is appropriate. This ordinance shall, within 15 days of adoption, be published

once in a newspaper of general circulation, printed and published in the County of Siskiyou.
