BVP will reimburse the county up to 50% of BVP's estimated cost per ballistic vest up to \$850.00 for each.		
Therefore, the reimbursement maximum per vest is \$425.00, even if our vests cost more than \$800.00 per vest. We applied for 22 vests with consideration of expiration dates, turnover and new hires. Our estimation of expenses would be approx \$22,676.00 with maximum reimbursement from BVP to be \$13,838.00
