

The proposed project is to update the Siskiyou County Community Wildfire Protection Plan (SCCWPP) focusing on planning and prevention solutions to areas in the State Responsibility Areas (SRA) concentrating on the Wildland Urban Interface (WUI) boundaries. This project will result in an up-to-date comprehensive strategy for wildfire prevention, prevention education, fuel reduction, and more safely facilitate fighting wildfires that occur in Siskiyou County’s SRA.

We support the Weed Community Wildfire Protection Plan and view this as an opportunity for further fire safe education and to assist our communities in the quest to make Siskiyou County more resilient. We highly encourage CALFIRE to fund this project.
