Dear Shelly Davis:

The Center at Sierra Health Foundation intends to contract with the Siskiyou County Public Health Department for the period January 1, 2024, to June 30, 2027, to provide community harm reduction services through the California Overdose Prevention and Harm Reduction Initiative (COPHRI), a four-year program established by the California Budget Act of 2023-2024 through the California Department of Public Health. You will be invited to apply for up to \$630,000 of funding over the 42-month project period, or an average of \$15,000 per month. Please note that while we expect funding to be available for the full term, funding is contingent on allocation of funds in the state budget, which is determined on an annual basis.
