He was not receiving the assistance the 504 legally entitled him to. As a result, I witnessed in a short time him become depressed, wake each morning feeling defeated before he started, and slowly loose the will to try. It was heart breaking! Enrolling him in Golden Eagle was the answer to my prayers! He, for the 1st time in YEARS, is excited to go to school. He feels seen, his self esteem is climbing, in just 3 months of being there, he finally reached grade level math, something the other schools were never able to achieve. Instead of stressed and defeated, he is happy and for the first time ever, thinking about his future. I really am grateful for them. I really hope you approve their move to the other campus. Where they are now isn't as safe as where they want to move. I do not allow my child to walk home, because of the freeway offramp being right there. People fly off that offramp. I don't understand why

their moving to the other campus is an issue. Golden Eagle genuinely cares about the well being of our children. Our children would be able to safely be able to walk to and from school at the new location, without fear of being hit by a car, or someone lurking in the forest. That simple fact alone, should make it a no brainer, and anyone standing against it should be made to walk both locations themselves to see and understand the difference.
