Golden Eagle Charter School is working on building a new building on the Mt. Shasta campus to allow the high school program to move to the same location. The goal is to have all south county students in one location. Golden Eagle has provided multiple studies completed by professionals to ensure the school would not cause adverse effects to the environment.

These studies include a biological study, traffic study and noise study. The noise study met the limits as per the county guidelines. Golden Eagle Charter School is working with the county to install the appropriate school speed limit signs. Golden Eagle Charter has made every effort to follow the recommendations of the county to comply with the county ordinances.
