2nd ADDENDUM TO CONTRACT FOR SERVICES BY INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR

THIS 2nd ADDENDUM is to that Contract for Services entered into on June 8, 2023, and as amended on June 10, 2024, by and between the County of Siskiyou ("County") and California Hearing Officers, LLP ("Contractor") and is entered into on the date when it has been both approved by the Board and signed by all other parties to it.

WHEREAS, the Contract expires on June 30, 2025, and services continued to be required after that date; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to extend the term of the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the cost of services to be provided under the Contract is expected to exceed the amount provided in the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to increase the amount of compensation payable under the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the Scope of Service, Exhibit A, needs to be revised to reflect FY25/26 rates; and

WHEREAS, the General Liability minimum coverage has increased in the Contract in Section 5.06; and

NOW THEREFORE, THE PARTIES MUTUALLY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

Paragraph 1.01 of the Contract for Services shall be amended to extend the term of the contract through June 30, 2026.

Paragraph 3.01 of the Contract, Scope of Services, Exhibit "A", shall be deleted and replaced in its entirety with the new Exhibit "A", Scope of Services, attached hereto and hereby incorporated by reference.

Paragraph 4.01 of the Contract, Compensation, shall be amended to add an additional Twenty-Seven Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$27,000) for FY25/26 to increase the total compensation payable under the Contract to an amount not to exceed Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars and no/100 (\$75,000.00) for the term of the Contract.

Paragraph 5.06 of the Contract, General Liability insurance, shall increase from \$1,000,000.00 to \$2,000,000.00.

All other terms and conditions of the Contract shall remain in full force and effect.

I. Scope of Services

- 1. California Hearing Officers, LLP ("CHO") shall be responsible for performing all of the necessary duties and responsibilities of a certification hearing officer pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code 5250 et seq.
- 2. Certification review hearings may be conducted through the use of HIPPA-compliant electronic conferencing technology as necessary.

II. Compensation FY23/24

1. County shall compensate Contractor as prescribed in Article 4 of the Agreement.

2. A flat fee of \$1,000.00 per month shall be charged by CHO to the County regardless of whether any hearings occur during the month, effective July 1, 2023.

- 3. For any hearings that occur, the hourly rate shall be \$300.00 per hour, with a one- hour minimum. Additional time shall be billed in 15-minuteincrements.
- If all hearings scheduled for the day are cancelled by the County with less than 24-hour notice, the one-hour minimum rate of \$300.00 shall apply for that day.
- 5. CHO shall not charge the County for any overhead expenses. The County shall not pay for any overhead expenses. Overhead expenses include but are not limited to scheduling, secretarial services, telephone, photocopying, postage, and other administrative costs.

- d. If all hearings scheduled for the day are cancelled by the County with less than 48-hour notice, the one-hour minimum rate of \$300.00 shall apply for thatday.
- e. CHO shall not charge the County for any overhead expenses. The County shall not pay for any overhead expenses. Overhead expenses include but are not limited to scheduling, secretarial services, telephone, photocopying, postage, and other administrative costs.
