THIRD ADDENDUM TO CONTRACT FOR SERVICES BY INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR

THIS THIRD ADDENDUM is to that Contract for Services entered into on July 1, 2020, and as amended on March 4, 2021 by and between the County of Siskiyou ("County") and Debra Davis (Contractor") and is entered into on the date when it has been both approved by the Board and signed by all other parties to it.

WHEREAS, the cost of services to be provided under the Contract is expected to exceed the amount provided in the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to increase the amount of compensation payable under the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the Scope of Service, Exhibit A, needs to be revised to reflect additional duties.

NOW THEREFORE, THE PARTIES MUTUALLY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

Paragraph 3.01 of the Contract, Scope of Services, Exhibit "A", shall be deleted and replaced in its entirety with the new Exhibit "A", Scope of Services, attached hereto and hereby incorporated by reference.

Paragraph 4.01 of the Contract, Compensation, shall be amended to add an additional One Thousand and Five Hundred dollars (\$1,500), to increase the compensation payable under the Contract to an amount not to exceed Two Hundred Fourteen Thousand and Seven Hundred dollars (\$214,700) for the term of the Contract.

All other terms and conditions of the Contract shall remain in full force and effect.

To whom it may concern:

Reporting to the County Librarian, the Adult and Family Literacy Coordinator will be responsible for, but not limited to, the following duties within the Siskiyou County Library system:

- Train new literacy coaches
- Support for current coaches
- Screen new students
- Keep accurate records for reporting to the California State Library
- · Order literacy-related material and supplies
- Promote the program throughout the County
- Attend Literacy meetings and conferences outside of the county, as needed
- Coordinate and establish family literacy programming, including identifying new partners

The Adult and Family Literacy Coordinator will be compensated at a rate of \$2,400 per month, and prorated if partial month worked, for services provided.

For travel, the Adult Literacy Coordinator will be reimbursed for mileage to visit Library Branches and home visits, and mileage, meals and hotels for any conference they attend, a value not to exceed \$500.00. For out-of-county travel, they will submit documentation of the conference and original itemized receipts for reimbursement of meals and hotel stays.

Total compensation for services and travel reimbursement will not exceed the total cost cited in 4.01.

The Adult Literacy Coordinator will submit a monthly invoice to the County Librarian for payment that will detail hours worked and miles traveled while performing services as Adult Literacy Coordinator.
