WHEREAS, the cost of services to be provided under the contract is expected to exceed the amount provided in the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to increase the amount of compensation payable under the contract; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend Exhibit A to reflect the current rates of attorneys and staff, for which the County receives discounted rates.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PARTIES MUTUALLY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

Paragraph 3 of the Professional Services Retention Agreement shall be amended to add an additional Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00), to increase the compensation payable under the Contract to an amount not to exceed Seven Hundred Forty-Four Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$744,750.00).

Exhibit A of the Agreement shall be substituted with the new Exhibit A rates, attached hereto and hereby incorporated by reference effective September 2025.

All other terms and conditions of the Contract for Services shall remain in full force and effect.
