### SECOND ADDENDUM TO CONTRACT FOR SERVICES BY INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR

THIS SECOND ADDENDUM is to that Contract for Services entered into on March 24, 2023, and as amended on February 8, 2024, by and between the County of Siskiyou ("County") and Crestwood Behavioral Health, Inc. ("Contractor") and is entered into on the date when it has been both approved by the Board and signed by all other parties to it.

WHEREAS the cost of services to be provided under the Contract is expected to exceed the amount provided in the Contract; and

WHEREAS the parties desire to increase the amount of compensation payable under the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the Scope of Service, Exhibit "A1", needs to be revised to reflect the provided rates effective July 1, 2025, and

WHEREAS the General Liability minimum coverage has increased in the Contract in Section 5.06:

WHEREAS the Professional Liability minimum coverage has increased in the Contract in Section 5.10:

WHEREAS the cost of services to be provided under the Contract is expected to exceed the amount provided in the Contract; and

NOW THEREFORE, THE PARTIES MUTUALLY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

Paragraph 3.01 of the Contract, Scope of Services, Exhibit "A1", shall be deleted and replaced in its entirety with the new Exhibit "A1", Scope of Services, attached hereto and hereby incorporated by reference.

Paragraph 5.06 of the Contract, General Liability and Automobile Insurance shall increase from \$1,000,000 to \$2,000,000.

Paragraph 5.10 of the Contract, Professional Liability insurance shall increase from \$1,000,000 to \$2,000,000, provided that any medical provider subcontractors shall be required to carry professional liability coverage of \$1,000,000 per occurrence, \$3 million aggregate.

All other terms and conditions of the Contract shall remain in full force and effect.

Dear Sarah,

Wishing you and your loved ones a safe and peaceful 2025 filled with new opportunities and success for the County you serve. Crestwood is looking forward to a year of continued collaboration and success with Siskiyou County in the new year.

As we prepare for this year's services, resources, staffing recruitment and retention, and budgets for FY 2025/26, we are reaching out to you with our updated rate request related to specific services and communities.

### In 2025 Crestwood plans to focus on:

- Suicide prevention as we continue to see the remnants of the pandemic that caused loneliness, hopelessness and isolation that is leading to the increased risk of suicide. We see this risk in our communities and are committed to addressing it with peer support; Community Resiliency Model (CRM); trauma-support services; substance use treatment; Dialectical Behavior Therapy (DBT); and Wellness Recovery Action Plan (WRAP), which all focus on building hope, self-efficacy and community integration.
- In response to SB 43 and to address the needs of persons served and our communities, we
  completed a substance use treatment pilot program and are rolling out enhanced substance
  use treatment in our crisis programs, PHFs and MHRCs. We have Kristin Dempsey leading
  the Motivational Interviewing aspect and our quality education team providing the
  curriculum and treatment fundamentals.

#### Crestwood has expanded our recovery and resilience efforts, including:

- Crestwood Recovery and Resilience Solutions' (CRRS) bi-monthly podcasts with national leaders including Pat Deegan, Ron Manderscheid, Robert Whitaker, Ken Minkoff, and Paolo Del Vecchio.
- CRRS opened the only Peer Employment Learning Center (PELC) in the state, supporting the Peer Support Specialist (PSS) training leading to certification for peers across California and persons served in our Social Rehab Residential programs providing supervised internship. Crestwood has had 4 campuses immersed in the PELC pilot with 49 clients completing the Medi-Cal PSS certification training. Crestwood has hired 16 graduated clients with more yet to be hired.

- Crestwood Research Center partnering with Rutgers University, UC Davis, Stanford University, UCSF and leading researchers to provide innovative solutions to the daily challenges of behavioral healthcare, including intensifying our Trauma-Informed environments and justice-engaged services. We will continue to present our data across the state and country.
