

THIRD ADDENDUM TO CONTRACT FOR SERVICES BY INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR

THIS THIRD ADDENDUM is to that Contract for Services entered into on June 30th 2023 and as amended on August 1st 2023 and July 26, 2024 by and between the County of Siskiyou ("County") and M. Peters, Inc. ("Contractor") and is entered into on the date when it has been both approved by the Board and signed by all other parties to it.

WHEREAS, the Contract expired on December 31, 2024 and services continued to be required after that date; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to extend the term of the Contract;

WHEREAS, the cost of services to be provided under the Contract is expected to exceed the amount provided in the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to increase the amount of compensation payable under the Contract.

WHEREAS, the Scope of Service, Exhibit A, needs to be revised to reflect additional duties.

NOW THEREFORE, THE PARTIES MUTUALLY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

Paragraph 1.01 of the Contract for Services shall be amended to extend the term of the Contract through June 30, 2025.

Paragraph 3.01 of the Contract, Scope of Services, Exhibit "A", shall be deleted and replaced in its entirety with the new Exhibit "A", Scope of Services, attached hereto and hereby incorporated by reference.

Paragraph 4.01 of the Contract, Compensation, shall be amended to add an additional Two Hundred Seventy Thousand Dollars and no cents (\$270,000.00), to increase the compensation payable under the Contract to an amount not to exceed One Million Thirty Five Thousand and no cents (\$1,035,000.00) for the term of the Contract.

All other terms and conditions of the Contract shall remain in full force and effect.
