

**FOURTH ADDENDUM TO CONTRACT FOR SERVICES
BY INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR**

THIS FOURTH ADDENDUM is to that Contract for Services entered into on July 1, 2021, and as amended on January 1, 2023, and on May 7, 2024, and on April 17, 2025 by and between the County of Siskiyou (“County”) and Lawrence & Associates, Inc. (“Contractor”) and is entered into on the date when it has been both approved by the Board and signed by all other parties to it.

WHEREAS, the Third Addendum to the Contract expired on December 31, 2025, and services continued to be required after that date; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to extend the term of the Contract;

WHEREAS, the cost of services to be provided under the Contract is expected to exceed the amount provided in the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to increase the amount of compensation payable under the contract; and

WHEREAS, the Scope of Service, Exhibit “A”, needs to be repealed and replaced to reflect additional duties and compensation.

WHEREAS, the Workers’ compensation Insurance in Contract section 5.04 shall be amended to establish a minimum limit of coverage.

WHEREAS, the Liability minimum coverage has increased in the Contract in Section 5.05.

WHEREAS, the General Liability minimum coverage has increased in the contract in section 5.06.

WHEREAS, the Professional Liability minimum coverage has increased in the Contract in section 5.10.

NOW THEREFORE, THE PARTIES MUTUALLY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

Paragraph 1.01 of the Contract for Services shall be amended to extend the term of the Contract through December 31, 2026.

Paragraph 3.01 of the Contract, Scope of Services, Exhibit “A” shall be deleted and replaced in its entirety with the new Exhibit “A”, Scope of Services, attached here to and hereby incorporated by reference.

Paragraph 4.01 of the Contract, Compensation, shall be amended to add an additional One Hundred Seven Thousand, Ten Dollars and No/100 cents (\$107,010.00), to

increase the compensation payable under the Contract to an amount not to exceed Five Hundred Twenty-Six Thousand, Five Hundred Thirty-Eight and No/100 cents (\$526,538.00).

Paragraph 5.04 of the Contract, worker's compensation shall be amended to establish a minimum limit of \$1,000,000.00 for Workers' Compensation Insurance.

Paragraph 5.05 of the Contract, Indemnification shall be amended to increase the required limit for Liability Insurance from \$1,000,000.00 to \$2,000,000.00.

Paragraph 5.06 of the Contract, General Liability, and Automobile Insurance shall be amended to increase the required limit for General Liability Insurance from \$1,000,000.00 to \$2,000,000.00, and is further amended to state: "If the contractor maintains broader coverage and/or higher limits than the minimums shown on the Contract, the County requires and shall be entitled to the broader coverage and/or the higher limits maintained by the contractor. Any available insurance proceeds in excess of the specified minimum limits of insurance and coverage shall be available to the County."

Paragraph 5.10 of the Contract, Professional Liability shall be amended to increase the required limit for Professional Liability Insurance from \$1,000,000.00 to \$2,000,000.00.

All other terms and conditions of the Contract shall remain in full force and effect.
