RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SISKIYOU
AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE AWARD UNDER THE US
DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE
KEVIN & AVONTE PROGRAM: REDUCING INJURY & DEATH GRANT FOR
COUNTY OF SISKIYOU

WHEREAS, the US Department of Justice (DOJ), Office of Justice Program (OJP), Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA), desires to educate first responders, school staff, caregivers, and families about reducing wandering risks for people living with forms of dementia or developmental disabilities by implementing an innovative wearable tracking technology pilot program. In addition to funding the purchase of the tracking devices, it will fund for prevention, intervention, and rescue programs. The SF-424 submittal to the DOJ is due February 20, 2026, the application deadline is February 27, 2026, with a project start date of October 1, 2026 through October 31, 2029, for an allocation of \$150,000.00 with spending authority through October 31, 2029.

WHEREAS, County of Siskiyou (“County”) desires to compete for the DOJ Kevin & Avonte Program Grant and accept the funding if successful in the competition;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors for Siskiyou County does hereby determine and declare as follows:

SECTION 1. That County is hereby authorized and directed to compete for and accept the DOJ Kevin & Avonte Program Grant competitive allocation award, as detailed in the Notice of Intent, up to the amount authorized.

SECTION 2. That the County Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to act on behalf of the County in connection with the DOJ Kevin & Avonte Program Grant, and to enter into, execute, and deliver any and all documents required or deemed necessary or appropriate to be awarded the DOJ Kevin & Avonte Program Grant, and all amendments thereto.

SECTION 3. That County shall be subject to the terms and conditions specified in the DOJ Kevin & Avonte Program Grant Funding Award Program Documents, and

that County will use the award funds in accordance with the DOJ Kevin & Avonte Program Grant Funding requirements, and any other applicable rules or laws.
