

**4th ADDENDUM TO CONTRACT FOR SERVICES
BY INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR**

THIS 4th ADDENDUM is to that Contract for Services entered into on July 29, 2022, and as amended on October 17, 2023, and December 3, 2024, and October 8, 2025 by and between the County of Siskiyou ("County") and Applied Survey Research, a non-profit 501 (c) (3) ("Contractor") and is entered into on the date when it has been both approved by the Board and signed by all other parties to it.

WHEREAS, the Contract expires on June 30, 2026, and services continued to be required after that date; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to extend the term of the Contract.

WHEREAS, the cost of services to be provided under the Contract is expected to exceed the amount provided in the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to increase the amount of compensation payable under the Contract.

NOW THEREFORE, THE PARTIES MUTUALLY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

Paragraph 1.01 of the Contract for Services shall be amended to extend the term of the Contract through June 30, 2027.

Paragraph 3.01 of the Contract, Compensation, shall be amended to add an additional Thirty-Six Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars and No/100 Cents (\$36,800.00), to increase the compensation payable under the Contract to an amount not to exceed One Hundred Seventy One Thousand Fifty Dollars and No/100 Cents (\$171,050.00).

All other terms and conditions of the Contract shall remain in full force and effect.
