G. Additional Information. 1. Briefly describe the area to be served: fire protection system, water system, equipment, facilities, staffing, hazards, etc. and purpose of proposed project. 2. Siskiyou County is the 5th largest county in California with an area of 6347 Sq miles, and is located within the inland portion of northern California directly adjacent to the Oregon border. The County features natural beauty and scenic towns that draw in thousands of people annually for travel and recreation. Interstate 5 runs through the center of the county which creates a large impact on the resources provided by the volunteer departments. The County has topographic extremes from lush valley floors to the alpine peaks of Mt Shasta that are heavily affected by extreme weather conditions. Summer temps climb above 100 degrees while winter temps drop well below freezing with significant snowstorms. Fuel types in the county include timber, timber with a grass under-story grass, brush, oak woodland, desert sage and western juniper stands, and the county experiences a high occurrence of lightning activity during the summer months. The area served by this project includes 28, mostly volunteer, fire departments located throughout Siskiyou County. Approximately 450 volunteers staff the 28 departments. The purpose of the proposed project is to provide the firefighters with the safety equipment needed to suppress wildland fires safely and meet NFPA 1977 and NFPA 1981 standards.

In addition to the original request(s), Applicants may list alternative projects for excess or unused funds, which the State will review during the initial application process. The State will determine which of the Applicant's projects are eligible for funding if excess or unused funds become available. Upon advance written approval by the State, the applicant may use additional/excess funding up to the contract maximum amount to purchase State approved items in listed order of priority on their application.

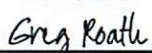
Deviations from the original application are considered an amendment and require prior approval before the amended expenditures can be made.
