

**FIRST ADDENDUM TO CONTRACT FOR SERVICES
BY INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR**

THIS FIRST ADDENDUM is to that Contract for Services entered into on February 1, 2026, by and between the County of Siskiyou ("County") and Social Change Partners, LLC. ("Contractor") and is entered into on the date when it has been both approved by the Board and signed by all other parties to it.

WHEREAS, the Contract expires on June 30, 2026, and services continue to be required after that date; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to extend the term of the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the cost of services to be provided under the Contract is expected to exceed the amount provided in the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to increase the amount of compensation payable under the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the Scope of Service, Exhibit A, needs to be revised to reflect additional duties.

NOW THEREFORE, THE PARTIES MUTUALLY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

Paragraph 1.01 of the Contract for Services shall be amended to extend the term of the Contract through June 30, 2027.

Paragraph 3.01 of the Contract, Scope of Services, Exhibit "A", shall be deleted and replaced in its entirety with the new Exhibit "A", Scope of Services, attached hereto and hereby incorporated by reference

Paragraph 4.01 of the Contract, Compensation, shall be amended to add an additional FORTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$40,000.00), to increase the compensation payable under the Contract to an amount not to exceed EIGHTY-NINE THOUSAND DOLLARS AND 00/100 CENTS (\$89,000.00).

All other terms and conditions of the Contract shall remain in full force and effect.

Exhibit "A"

A. Specific Services:

Pursuant to Section 3.01, County shall comply with provisions as set forth in Senate Bill No. 89, CHAPTER 24, STATUTES OF 2017.

1. County shall conduct a 5-year County Self-Assessment which includes but is not limited to the following actions:
 - a. Aggregate and analyze all available required and recommended data and information, including Performance Measures, Customer Satisfaction Survey results, County Data Dashboard, and local ad hoc reports, as well as existing organizational assessments and analytics.
 - b. Seek feedback from internal and external stakeholders to Identify strengths and weaknesses of current program practices and resource deployment.
 - c. Develop a CalWORKs County Self-Assessment (Cal-CSA) report.
 - d. Facilitate Peer Review participation groups.
 - e. Develop a CalWORKs System Improvement Plan (Cal-SIP) report.
 - f. Evaluate and implement strategies for improvement in the CalWORKs Program, as described in the Cal-SIP.
 - g. Report Progress on Continuous Quality Improvement (CQI) including continuation of the peer review process and submittal of two (2) Cal-SIP Progress Report(s).

B. Specific Services:

Pursuant to Section 3.01, Contractor shall:

1. Reconvene the Cal-OAR Team
 - a. Confirm roles and responsibilities.
 - b. Determine methods of consultation with stakeholders.
 - c. Facilitate review of the Cal-CSA.
 - d. Facilitate review of the Cal-SIP and Progress Reports.
2. Technical Assistance specific to data pulling and analysis of Cal-OAR data.
 - a. Conduct a literature review on CQI best practices and CDSS reporting requirements, incorporating suggestions based on Cal-OAR guidance.

- b. Provide staff training in data analysis associated with Cal-SIP measures.
- c. Participate in collaborative meetings and training sessions with CDSS Cal-OAR team.
- d. Assist staff in establishing the data reporting process.
- e. Support staff in consistent tracking and protocols for conducting regular quality checks and ensuring data integrity, in alignment with Continuous Quality Improvement (CQI) principles.
- f. Engage in strategic planning sessions to translate data insights into actionable strategies and goals for the upcoming Cal-OAR cycle.
- g. Continue active participation in collaborative meetings with the CDSS Cal-OAR team, providing progress updates, sharing lessons learned, and aligning efforts with state-level objectives.

C. Compensation:

Pursuant to Section 4.01, County shall pay to Contractor as compensation in full for all services and associated costs, an additional fee not to exceed \$40,000, for a total fee not to exceed \$89,000. Pricing as follows:

- 1. Data Technical Assistance \$40,000 additional
