

**SECOND ADDENDUM TO CONTRACT FOR SERVICES
BY INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR**

THIS SECOND ADDENDUM is to that Contract for Services entered into on May 7, 2024, and as amended by the First Addendum on June 18, 2025, by and between the County of Siskiyou ("County") and Dr. Kitt Murrison, Ph.D. ("Contractor") and is entered into on the date signed by all parties to it.

WHEREAS, the Contract expired on June 30, 2026, and services continued to be required after that date; and

WHEREAS, the parties agree to an increase in certain fees; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to extend the term of the Contract;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE PARTIES MUTUALLY AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

Paragraph 1.01 of the Contract for Services shall be amended to extend the term of the contract through December 31, 2026.

Paragraph 3.01 of the Contract for Services, Exhibit A Scope of Services shall be amended to increase the fee for initial/new employee psychological evaluations/assessments from \$500.00 each to \$550.00 each.

All other terms and conditions of the Contract for Services shall remain in full force and effect.

EXHIBIT A

SCOPE OF SERVICES

Revised April 16, 2026

Contractor will perform psychological evaluations/assessments to include the following:

- 60–120-minute interview of the applicant covering areas such as social history, past and present family history, education and occupational history, career motivation, level of emotional function, and problematic behavioral history.
- Review records and incorporate information submitted by the Siskiyou County Probation Department as appropriate.
- Administration of the Comprehension and Similarities Subtests from the Wechsler Adult Intelligence Scale III or IV in order to assess general reasoning and logical thinking, conceptual and abstract thinking, and overall critical thinking abilities.
- Administration of the Minnesota Multiphasic Personality Inventory – II or III and the 16 PF (5th edition) Personality test in order to obtain profiles related to specific and general levels of personality functioning, problem-solving style, and propensity toward exhibiting psychopathology.
- Provide a detailed written report to the Siskiyou County Probation Department within two weeks of the evaluation.
- If requested by the Chief Probation Officer, the contractor shall store and maintain all evaluation reports at the contractor's place of business to prevent issues with confidentiality within the probation department.
- Provide a certification form for the department's file.

Contractor will invoice the County:

- \$550.00 each for initial/new employee psychological evaluation/assessment.
- \$400.00 each psychological re-evaluation/re-assessment within the same year.
- Contractor may charge a no-show fee of \$200.00 if the County/Client does not cancel or reschedule the appointment with at least a 24 hours' notice.
