RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SISKIYOU
AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A GIFT OF SAFETY PARTNERSHIP
AWARD UNDER THE BUCKLE UP FOR LIFE PROGRAM FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026–
2027, FOR COUNTY OF SISKIYOU

WHEREAS, Buckle Up for Life, a national child passenger safety program supported by Toyota and Cincinnati Children’s Hospital Medical Center, offers a competitive Gift of Safety partnership that provides car seats, educational resources, and program support for child passenger safety programs across North America during the August 1, 2026 – July 31, 2027 program period; and

WHEREAS, the Gift of Safety program provides selected partners with 50 convertible car seats, training, car seat installation requirements, and access to online educational materials and curricula, with no direct monetary funding provided; and

WHEREAS, eligible partners must be public service or governmental entities, including local health departments, operating under their own EIN/TIN, and must have at least one certified Child Passenger Safety Technician (CPST) on staff, and must commit to distributing all provided car seats at no cost, with proper installation assistance and required educational interactions as specified by the program guidelines; and

WHEREAS, the County of Siskiyou (“County”), through its Public Health Division, desires to participate in the Buckle Up for Life Gift of Safety program for the purpose of strengthening community child passenger safety efforts and serving families in need throughout the County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors for Siskiyou County does hereby determine and declare as follows:

SECTION 1. The County is authorized and directed to accept the Buckle Up for Life – Gift of Safety 2026–2027 partnership award, including the in-kind allocation of 50 convertible car seats and associated program resources, subject to all program expectations and requirements.

SECTION 2. The County Administrator, or their designee, is authorized to act on behalf of the County in connection with the Gift of Safety partnership, including the execution of all documents, agreements, reporting requirements, and program

compliance tasks deemed necessary or appropriate to participate in the program, similar to the authority granted in other program funding resolutions.

SECTION 3. The County acknowledges and agrees to comply with all Gift of Safety partner requirements, including but not limited to: Distributing all provided car seats free of charge with installation assistance by a CPST; providing child passenger safety education to each family receiving a car seat; targeting at-risk populations where possible; completing all required reports, data submissions, and participation in mandatory orientation webinars.
