

**PROCLAMATION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY
OF SISKIYOU RECOGNIZING NATIONAL HUNTING AND FISHING DAY,
SEPTEMBER 26, 2026**

WHEREAS, on May 2, 1972 the first proclamation of National Hunting and Fishing Day was signed; and

WHEREAS hunting and fishing have long been a central part of the Siskiyou County and California outdoor experience. For Native Americans and the first settlers, these activities were vital to survival, and even today many families rely on the bounty of our natural resources; and

WHEREAS hunting and fishing families share the abundant beauty of the outdoors, passing on traditions, bonding with friends and family, and teaching children the importance of protecting and respecting natural resources; and

WHEREAS California anglers and hunters contribute over one hundred million dollars each year through California Department of Fish and Wildlife licenses and permits, supporting healthy public and private lands, ecosystems, and wildlife, while also enhancing the economies of rural counties; and

WHEREAS, Siskiyou County anglers and hunters recognize that sound stewardship of our natural resources and responsible management of our exceptional public lands ensure that future generations may enjoy the same benefits entrusted to us by those who established conservation principles for fish and wildlife.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Siskiyou County Board of Supervisors encourages Siskiyou County hunters and anglers to recognize National Hunting and Fishing Day on September 26, 2026, by celebrating with family and friends and enjoying the great outdoors.
